Advice for Younger Choir Students: Don't worry how to please others, just be yourself and if people don't like you then that's okay because if they can't see how great you are, then that's their problem.

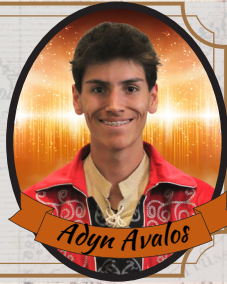
